



Dear Order of the Arrow Candidate:

The Order of the Arrow (OA) is Scouting's National Honor Society chartered by the Boy Scouts of America. Founded in 1915, the OA recognizes campers who best exemplify the Scout Oath and Law in their daily lives, promotes camping, and crystallizes the habit of cheerful service as a life purpose. It is an organization composed of Scouts (called arrowman) from different Troops, Ships and Crews, and is led by those Scouts under the guidance of selected adult advisers.

As a result of an OA election conducted at your unit within the past year, you were chosen as a candidate for induction into the Order of the Arrow. In order to become a new member, you must complete the Induction Weekend within one year from the date of your election. The Induction lasts from Friday night until Sunday morning, and you MUST complete the entire Induction Weekend to become a member. If you fail to complete your Induction within one and a half years (1.5 years) from your election, you must be re-elected by your unit.

- The weekend will be held at Rancho Los Mochos (Livermore hills) beginning on Friday evening (03/22), through Sunday (03/24). <u>Candidates need to arrive at camp between 8:00 PM and 9:00 PM Friday evening</u>.
- If you are over 18, you must meet additional requirements, see bottom of next page.

Please note that dinner is not provided Friday night, so you should have dinner before arriving at camp. Attached is a list of what to bring. Your parent/guardian should arrive by 10:30 AM so please plan on leaving camp around 11:00 am on Sunday morning.

Enclosed with this letter you should find all the information needed. We cannot reiterate the importance of you bringing a copy of the BSA Medical Forms (A and B) and having your parent/guardian sign it. Failure to have the medical form filled out and signed means you will be unable to participate in the scheduled Induction.

The cost for the Induction Weekend is \$85.00. The fee, combined with a subsidy from our Lodge, will cover:

- Cost of the weekend including food
- OA membership dues for the remainder of the current year
- OA sash
- OA handbook
- 1 Lodge pocket flap

Things to Bring to the Induction Weekend

- 1. BSA Medical form (Parts A&B)
- 2. Uniform and Class B Shirt
- 3. Warm sleeping bag
- 4. Ground cloth AND a small/personal tent
- 5. Warm jacket or sweater
- 6. Sturdy pair of work shoes or boots (closed toe only)
- Set of work clothes including long pants (Recommend a long sleeve shirt as well)
- 8. Work gloves
- 9. Personal Camp Chair
- 10. Hat (Recommended)
- 11. Sun protection (Sunglasses and sunscreen)
- 12. Water bottle (Reusable)
- 13. Personal first aid kit
- 14. Rain gear
- 15. Toiletries (toothbrush, toothpaste, etc)
- 16. Flash light
- 17. Extra set of clothing
- 18. Face masks (For COVID Protection)
- 19. Money for our Trading Post of Lodge items (Neckerchief, patches, and various other items).

Please NO matches, food and snacks. Leave your Merit Badge Sash and any medals at home.

If you are over 18, you must meet these additional requirements:

- 1. Have current Youth Protection Training (YPT) through Sunday, March 24, 2024.
- Be fully compliant with AB 506 which includes mandated state training and a Livescan background check. More information can be found at: <u>https://californiascouting.org</u>
